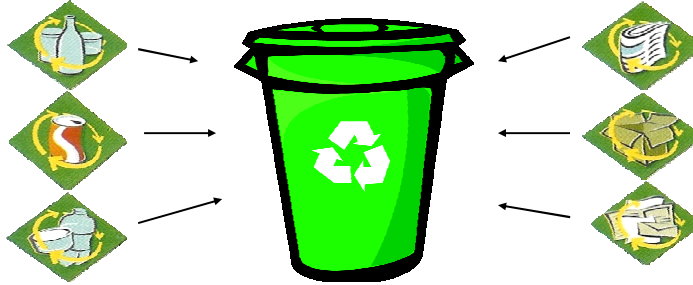
Recycle Pickup - Every Friday

ACCEPTABLE RECYCLING ITEMS

Clear or white plastic bags may be used as long as collector can determine it is recyclables.

ALL RECYCLABLES GO IN ONE CONTAINER

You may need more than one container depending on household usage.
Please rinse out all containers.



All recyclables can go in one container: glass bottles and jars, metal cans, plastic bottles and containers (marked #1 - 7), junk mail, mixed paper, newspapers, magazines, and cardboard.

Newspapers and cardboard need not be tied, however make sure they are securely in the container so not to blow out on windy days. Use a lid at all times.

Acceptable Recycled Items

Hard Cover & Paperback Books
Newspaper, Magazines & Junk Mail
Telephone Books
Cardboard & brown paper bags
Clean pizza box
Lightweight cardboard

Chipboard that disintegrates when wet.
For example: cereal & macaroni boxes.
Tin & Bi-Metal Cans (label can stay on).
Food Trays #1-7 (rinsed out).
Caps may be left on plastic bottles.
Glass bottles.
Aerosol cans

Aluminum cans (only empty beverage cans).

Plastic bottles and containers #1-7: All containers MUST be emptied and rinsed.

BRUSH COLLECTION

Brush will be collected by zone in accordance with the schedule above.

Items that ARE collected:

Tree limbs and branches:

No greater than 6" in diameter
All branches/limbs should face same direction

Small Brush/Debris:

Small branches/twigs when placed in garbage can
NOTE: If the branches/twigs are mixed in with dirt, rocks, roots, shrubs, leaves or vegetative waste, such as grass, vines or other plant life, **IT WILL NOT BE COLLECTED.**

We **DO NOT** take roots, root balls, shrubs/bushes, vines, vegetative waste, other plant life, leaves, stumps, dirt, and rocks.

GRASS CLIPPINGS



Grass clippings are picked up by the garbage hauler **THEY MUST BE IN SPECIAL PAPER BAGS.** Available at Shop Rite, Walmart, or your local home improvement center



LEAF COLLECTION

Leaves will be collected by zone in accordance with the schedule above.



There will be multiple trips through all neighborhoods for the duration of the leaf collection program. If leaves are not out when the crew goes by, they will be picked up next scheduled collection date.

The schedule is subject to inclement weather and other municipal emergencies.

A special springtime leaf collection will be scheduled the end of April/beginning of May, weather permitting. Once scheduled, the date will be placed on our website; clintonnj.gov.

DO NOT PUT BRUSH / YARD DEBRIS MIXED IN WITH LEAVES

Note: NO BRUSH will be picked up during leaf collection time.

CHRISTMAS TREES will be collected curbside the first 2 weeks of January

Garbage Pickup - Every Tuesday

REGULAR GARBAGE/TRASH

Every Tuesday at curbside (out before 7a.m.).

No building/construction materials, paint, auto parts, tree stumps, hazardous materials.

No electronics such as items with electric circuit boards in them such as televisions, radios, stereos, computers, monitors, etc.

These items can be taken to the Hunterdon County Complex at the electronic collection. Call 908-788-1351 for information and dates.

Other disposal options for electronics is Best Buy and Staples.

Air Conditioners and Refrigerators must have Freon removed before pick up can be made. A sticker identifying Freon has been removed must be attached.
